Prospectus and Regulations

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1. This event is open to Malaysian Citizens only
- 1.2. State Representatives
 - 1.2.1. Each state is allowed to register no more than four(4) players with a FIDE rating of 1600 or higher for each of the Open and Women category
 - 1.2.2. Each state is allowed to send no more than two (2) additional players with or without a FIDE rating for each Open and Women category but on a first come first serve basis limited to the number of seats and space available

1.3. Special Entries

- 1.3.1. All Former National Champions are eligible to play
- 1.3.2. SUKIPT Individual Champions 2018, National Junior Champions 2018, National Age Group Winners 2018 and MSSM Champion 2018 for both Open and Women sections are eligible to play
- 1.3.3. Medal winners at any 2018 Regional/International FIDE events
- 1.3.4. OKU National Winners 2018
- 1.4. Open Entries
 - 1.4.1. All players of Malaysian citizenship are allowed to participate in the Malaysia Chess Championship but entries are accepted based on seat and space availability
 - 1.4.2. Priority will be given to the State and Special entries

1.5. MCF Entries

1.5.1. MCF reserves the right to include additional players as and when required at its discretion

2. REGISRATION

- 2.1. Only the official entry form provided by the Organizers shall be accepted for player's registration

- 3.1. FIDE Laws of Chess shall be enforced throughout the championship
- 3.2. Championship format shall be as follows:
 - 3.2.1. Number of Rounds : 9 Rounds Swiss
 - 3.2.2. Event Category 3.2.3. Time control
- : Classical : 90 minutes + 30 seconds increment
- Waiting Time : 60 n
 - : 60 minutes
- 3.2.<mark>5. Tie</mark> Break
 - 3.2.5.1. Direct Encounter (to determine the Champion)
 - 3.2.5.1.1. Play off to be held if 3.2.5.1 is not conclusive
 - 3.2.5.1.2. The Chief Arbiter in consultation with the organizer will decide the playoff mode at the conclusion of the final round.
 - 3.2.5.2. Buchholz Cut 1
 - 3.2.5.3. Buchholz
 - 3.2.5.4. Sonneborn Berger
 - 3.2.5.5. Progressive Score
- 3.3. Appeals Committee
 - 3.3.1. An appeal committee consisting of five(5) member plus two(2) reserves shall be appointed during the player's meeting
 - 3.3.2. Appeals must be submitted in writing to the Organizing Committee within thirty(30) minutes at the conclusion of the disputed game accompanied with a RM500 appeal fee.
 - 3.3.3. If the appeal is upheld, the fee shall be returned or otherwise forfeited.
 - 3.3.4. Decisions arising from the appeal is final

3.4. Additional Championship Rules and Regulations

- 3.4.1. Players are required to wear smart casual, formal suits or state's jersey when entering the championship hall. Shorts, slippers, round neck t-shirts, attire with offensive wordings, skimpy and revealing clothing will not be allowed in the championship hall at all times.
- 3.4.2. A player who wishes to withdraw from the tournament is required to submit a letter in writing to the Chief Arbiter failing which disciplinary action will be taken against the player.
- 3.4.3. Additional Rules and Regulations specific to this championship imposed by the Organizing Committee or MCF/PCP, shall be made known to the player as and when required.
- 3.4.4. Player(s) who is found to repeatedly breach any of the rules and regulations imposed by the organizer including behaviours and attitudes unbecoming of a sportsman, shall be expelled from this and other chess tournaments or events in the future. In this case, the expelled player shall not have any right to any prizes, irrespective of his standing at the time of expulsion
