RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. INVITATION

1.1. PERSEKUTUAN CATUR MALAYSIA (MCF – The Malaysian Chess Federation) invites all Malaysians to participate in the National Rapid and Blitz Chess Championships 2021 from 24th to 26th December 2021

2. PARTICIPATION

- 2.1. The event is open to MALAYSIAN CITIZENS ONLY
- 2.2. All participants must have a valid FIDE ID
- 2.3. All participants must have received 2 doses of COVID19 vaccination
 - 2.3.1. For minors below the age of 18, parent consent is needed to participate in the event even if the player has completed its vaccination requirement
 - 2.3.2. For minors below the age of 18/12, both parents must have completed the required vaccination dosages
- 2.4. While the proof of vaccination is not required during the registration process, players/parents must be able to provide proof when requested by the organizing officials when physically present at the tournament venue. Players/parents who failed to provide the necessary credentials, will not be accepted to play and no refund will be entertained
- 2.5. By registering, each player agrees to abide by the Regulations of the championship, including the anti-cheating rules where applicable.

- 4.2. Proof of payment must be attached when submitting the registration form
- 4.3. <u>Dateline for registration is 17 December 2021</u>
- 4.4. The Federation reserves the right to reject an application without providing any reasons whatsoever.

5. ACCOMMODATIONS

- 5.1. HOTEL TENERA shall be the Official Hotel and Venue for the event however, players are free to choose and make their own accommodation arrangement
- 5.2. For those who prefer to stay at the hotel, special rates are given if bookings are made and confirmed via the Registration form.

8. SYSTEM OF PLAY

- 8.1. FIDE Laws of Chess for Rapid and Blitz (inadequate supervision) shall be used for the Championship
- 8.2. Both Rapid and Blitz events will be paired using Swiss Manager Pairing System.
- 8.3. Number of Rounds

Rapid – 9 Rounds Swiss Blitz – 11 Rounds Swiss

8.4. Time Control

Rapid – 20 mins + 10 secs Blitz – 3 mins + 2 secs

- 8.5. There is NO WAITING TIME imposed. Players are required to let the entire playing time to lapse if opponent is not present at the start of the round to claim for a win.
- 8.6. Tiebreaks (for both events)
 - a. Direct Encounter
 - b. Buchholz Cut 1
 - c. Buchholz
 - d. Sonnenborn-Berger
 - e. Cumulative

9. ANTI CHEATING

- 9.1. All participants shall comply and co-operate with the Organizer and Arbiter's Team with regards to Anti Cheating enforcement
- 9.2. If a player refuses to be inspected, he/she shall get a warning for non-compliance of Rules and Regulations. If the player continues to refuse being inspected by the Arbiter's Team, he/she shall lose the game and be precluded from further play in the tournament.
- 9.3. In any event, Arbiter's have the right to warn, penalize, disqualify, reverse the score, and/or expel any player who does not comply with the Laws of Chess, and/or does not abide by the Rules and Regulations of the tournament.
- 9.4. Players who are caught cheating shall be removed from the tournament and his/her scores to be reversed where applicable. A report shall be filed to FIDE and the player can be banned from playing in any chess tournaments or competitions between 2 and 5 years for a first-time offence, and up to a lifetime ban for continued offences.

10. PRIZES

- 10.1. Total Cash Prizes to be awarded shall be RM 5,000

11.1. All decisions made by the Chief Arbiter is considered as final. No Appeals are possible or accepted by the Organizer or the Arbiter's Team.

12. SELECTION FOR NATIONAL TEAM

12.1. The Malaysian Chess Federation Selection Committee may use the final results and rankings of this event as selection criteria to select National Players to represent Malaysia at upcoming regional/international events such as SEA Games, ASIAN Games and Chess Olympiad, including other age group events and/or invitational events where Malaysia has been invited to be represented.

13. DISCLAIMER

- 13.1. The Malaysian Chess Federation (MCF) has the right to change the schedule, change, amend or otherwise update the regulations, or decide for any matter that is not mentioned in this document, and/or any other documents that is directly or indirectly related to this Championship
- 13.2. By registering and agreeing to participate in this Championship, players and their accompanying party(ies), agree not to hold the Malaysian Chess Federation, the Management/Owner of Hotel Tenera, the Organizing Committee and/or its officials, the Arbiter's Team, and all other persons who are part of this championship, responsible or accountable for any damages or loss of any nature personal, financial or otherwise, sustained or experienced, prior to, during and throughout the course of the event.
