4. **PLAYING FORMAT**

The number of rounds to be played including the format of play - either Swiss or Round Robin, will only be determined once MCF has received the final list of players. Where possible, a minimum of 7 Rounds Swiss or a maximum of 8 Rounds Swiss shall be played for each category.

Where necessary, MCF reserves the right to combine two or more age categories into a single category. In such a situation, the ranking for the respective age category and number of prizes to be given away, will remain as is.
