PROSPECTUS

ORGANIZER

The NATIONAL SCHOLASTIC CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP 2024 is an event organized by the Persekutuan Catur Malaysia (MCF).

INTRODUCTION

Persekutuan Catur Malaysia (MCF – Malaysian Chess Federation) hereby invites all chess players to participate in National Scholastic Chess Championship 2024 for players under the age of 7 year, 9 year, 11 year, 13 year, 15 year and 17 years old for Open and Girls events, to be held from the 1st to 3rd of March 2024.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

The National Juniors Chess Championship 2024 shall be governed by the FIDE Laws of Chess, and the event only accepts entries from MALAYSIAN CITIZENS.

There are no limitations for the number of chess players fielded either by state or by open entries provided the player meets the age criteria.

EVENT DATES

The event is scheduled from 1st to 3rd of March 2024.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the event, the player must be a Malaysian Citizen in the following age groups:

Under 7: Born on or after 1st January 2017

Under 11: Born on or after 1st January 2013

Under 13: Born on or after 1st January 2011

Under 15: Born on or after 1st January 2007

REGISTRATION

All registration must be made via the official forms at https://forms.gle/bB4YzCVN5DL77iab6 Registration via other channels will not be accepted.

As this event is organized by the Malaysian Chess Federation, all players **MUST HAVE an MCF ID** prior to registering for the event. FIDE ID is not compulsory but good to have.

All players from other age groups are allowed to play in this event if they meet the age requirement. Girl players are allowed to play in the Open event but, for representation/eligibility purposes at international events, these players will only be eligible to be selected for the age group and gender that they have participated in.

ENTRY FEES

The Entry Fee is RM60 per player and the Proof of Payment must be attached when completing the registration.

Players who do not have an MCF ID are required to register for MCF ID at RM20 via the following link at https://rating.malaysiachess.my/register.aspx. Please take note that approval for MCF ID may take between 5 and 7 days.

CLOSING DATE

The closing date to register is Friday, 23rd February 2024.

The organizer reserves the right to accept entries after this date by imposing a late fee of RM50 and/or pending space/seat availability.

REFUND POLICY

No refund shall be entertained once the closing date has lapsed. For players who decided to withdraw before the closing date will only receive a 50% refund provided documentations are provided to justify the request to withdraw.

All certificates including participation will only be produced after the tournament has completed and will be distributed via link/email which can be downloaded.

There is no cash prize for this event.

TRAVELING, ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

All players participating in the National Scholastic Chess Championship 2024 including parents, coaches, and other accompanying members of the participants, shall be responsible for their own travelling cost, accommodation and meals including their own safety and well-being before, during, after and throughout the duration of the event.

The Malaysian Chess Federation will not be responsible for any expenses, financial losses and/or injury of any kind, terminal or fatal, experienced, or sustained by the player and/or their parents, coaches, or other accompanying members before, during, after and throughout the duration of the event.

INTERPRETATION OF THESE RULES and REGULATIONS

At any time during the National Scholastics Chess Championships 2024, any issues or grounds that are not covered or any unforeseen event that are not specified in this Rules and Regulations, shall be referred to the Organizing Committee, the Tournament Director and the Chief Arbiter for interpretation and final decision.

SAFETY PRACTICES

In the interest of Public Safety, Health and everyone's General Well Being, players and members of his/her family, group, etc. that are not well, or showing symptoms of being ill, will be requested to leave the tournament hall and seek medical treatment – at their own expenses, prior to being allowed to continue or return to the playing hall.

While wearing a face mask is optional, the organizer may ask a player to wear one, or have it removed (for security purposes) when entering the playing hall. Players or spectators not adhering to this regulation will be removed from the tournament hall and/or expelled from the tournament.

The Organizer will continue to practice online announcements policies with pairings to be posted on www.chess-results.com. No physical notices will be posted in the playing area unless necessary.

SELECTION FOR ASIAN and ASEAN LEVEL EVENTS

The Champion of each Open and Girls categories shall be given the first option to participate in similar age group events at the ASIAN and ASEAN level for the current year in 2024 as the official Malaysian representative. Terms of participation from the organizer may differ and will be at the organizer's discretion. Player's selection to represent Malaysia is also subjected to the changes and policy enforced by the Selection Committee.
