5. CONDITION OF ENTRY

- 1. This event is for MALAYSIAN CITIZENS only.
- 2. Players must have a FIDE ID and MCF ID to participate.
- 3. Players must have a minimum FIDE Standard Rating as follows:

OPEN Category - minimum Standard FIDE rating of 1800 WOMEN Category - minimum Standard FIDE rating of 1400

CHALLENGER Category - maximum Standard FIDE rating of 1800

Note: Women Players with a FIDE Rating can choose to play either in the

Women or Challenger Category

4. ALL OTB Titled Players (IM/FM/CM) and Previous National Champions (NM/WNM) are not allowed to play in the CHALLENGER Category regardless of Rating (unless Unrated).

5. UNRATED players to play in the CHALLENGER Category ONLY

6. **REGISTRATION**

- 1. OPEN/WOMEN Categories
 - a. All IM/WIM/NM/WNM and players with a FIDE Rating of 2200 and above are invited to participate for FREE provided item 5.2 are fulfilled. Please write an email to mcfsecretariat@malaysiachess.org if interested
 - b. State Representative
 - Each State is allowed to nominate TWO (2) players in the OPEN Category and TWO (2) players in the WOMEN CATEGORY provided the players has fulfilled item 5.2 and has a Standard FIDE Rating.

c. Open and Women Entries

- Any players with a FIDE Standard Rating of 1800 and above (for Men) and 1600 and above (for Women), can register to play in the Open/Women events
- Players below the rating requirement are accepted only if they are nominated by their respective State provided the State does not breach the two (2) players requirements.
- NO UNRATED PLAYERS will be allowed in the Open/Women events

2. CHALLENGER Category

- a. This is an open category for players below FIDE Standard Rating of 1800 (for Men) and FIDE Standard Rating of 1600 (For Women)
- b. Women players who have a FIDE Standard Rating between 1800 and 1600 are allowed to choose their event category Women or Challenger
- c. All Unrated players/Without Standard FIDE Rating MUST PLAY in this category.
- d. Each State allowed to nominate up to four (4) players for discounted fees

OPEN: Champion:RM2,000, 2nd:RM1,000, 3rd:RM500, Vet:RM300, U18:RM300 **WOMEN:** Champion:RM1,200, 2nd:RM700, 3rd:RM400, U18:RM200, U12:RM200 **CHALLENGER:** Champion:RM800, 2nd:RM500, 3rd:RM300, Best Women:RM200 2nd Women: RM150, 3rd Women: RM100, Veteran (50+):RM150, Veteran (Lady): RM150, Best U18/U12/U1600 /Unrated/OKU – RM150 each, Best SEGi – RM100 **NOTE:** For Each Category Prizes, at least three (3) players participating for each of the prizes for it to be awarded, and achieve at least a 50% score (4.5 points)

13. MALAYSIAN MASTERS CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP 2025

The top three (3) winners for Open and Women events – Champion, Runner Up and 2nd Runner Up, will earn automatic slots in the upcoming Malaysia Masters Chess Championship to be held between May and July in Kuala Lumpur. The winner of the Malaysian Masters will earn a spot at the Malaysian GM Invitational Chess Championship to be held in July/August 2025 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.

Where required and invited, the National Champions will represent Malaysia at Regional, Continental and International level events organized by FIDE, ACF and other International Chess entities.
